Accomplishments in 2020: As with many organizations, the pandemic changed goals and expectations. However, we are happy to announce that even without our normal fundraiser, MVP was able to raise over \$31,000. It should also be noted that we have no paid staff and 96% of the money raised was sent to Makindu Advanced Training College (MATC), in Kenya. We are very proud of our board and Executive Director. All have been to MATC, Kenya, and have witnessed the accomplishments of MVP and the Kenyan Board of MATC. Both boards have worked collaboratively to address the challenges. Prior to the pandemic, the school was approaching sustainability. With the school closed and no tuition coming in, money had to be provided by MVP for staff salaries and for supplies and equipment to make the school safe for students to return. Specific accomplishments are listed below:

^{*}Sponsored 17 students who live in extreme poverty

^{*}Paid teacher salaries for 6 months

^{*}Funded operational costs and equipment purchases

^{*}Paid a percentage of administrative costs in Kenya

^{*}Build a large hand washing station and added a portable stations for each classroom

^{*}Paid for materials to make masks

^{*}Provided money for soap and sanitizer
